Graduate Outcomes Plan 2023-2025

A. Introduction

Regent College London (RCL) is committed to enabling our students and alumni to successfully engage with employment opportunities.

This plan presents the steps we are taking to meet the requirements of the B3 condition set by the [Office for Students](#) (OfS) and ensure students receive up to date and relevant support to achieve their career aspirations.

B. Priorities

1. Embedding employability and careers support within the curriculum.

- a. Provide advice and guidance to academic colleagues on the key employability skills required in the professional workplace.
- b. Embed employability and career workshops during dedicated weeks within the semester structure.
- c. Design work experience options within programmes through internships to provide hands-on experiences which are transferrable and will support employment prospects.
- d. Work in partnership with the Placement Coordinators within the schools for networking, providing guidance to students and sharing information on vacancies and placements.

2. Work in partnership with professional services to provide a holistic approach to supporting students.

- a. Deliver an induction to new students where employability, career goal setting and graduate outcomes are embedded within the information students receive within the early stages of their journey at RCL.
- b. Provide employability and graduate work opportunities to students through personalised one to ones, targeted workshops and events, such as jobs fairs and external speakers.
- c. Provide a joined-up approach to supporting students through the promotion of SCOPE, Thinking into Character and other support services at RCL.
- d. Promote Careers Connect as a digital employability platform, where students can benefit from bitesize employability skills clips and the 360 CV service.
- e. Develop strong relationships with employers and in the higher education sector to provide the best opportunities for RCL students and alumni.

3. Engage RCL alumni to ensure further education and career opportunities are well signposted and supported.

- a. Deliver events such as job fairs and graduation to engage with alumni, maintaining a good relationship post completion.
- b. Promote networking and job opportunities through communication and alumni networks.
- c. Design targeted workshops with alumni, including business start up, self employment, and interview skills.
- d. Offer lifelong learning opportunities for the RCL alumni community to upskill and keep abreast of industry trends and standards.
